## TRANSPARENT PROTECTIVE BLAST PROTECTION LAMINATE

The blast protection label is used in order to prevent defined areas from being damaged during surface cleaning with blasting media. In particular markings and inscriptions remain recognisable beyond the blasting process. The removal is usually done manually after after painting. This is an important aspect in the context of traceability. This is a patented system that was designed to meet the requirements in steel construction.
